1. Location: Location: Between September 1 and September 26 artists may choose to paint at any location in University City. On October 1, the Plein Air Art Festival will again take place in

conjunction with the U City in Bloom Garden Tour. This year's tour will take place in the Musick and Meridian neighborhoods, with beautiful homes and gardens. And musicians will be in some gardens on the day of the Garden Tour. A list of featured gardens will be provided ahead of time to registered artists or upon same-day registration October 1.

- **2. Artistic Medium**: Any painting or drawing medium on canvas, board, or paper is allowed. Photography, computer-generated images, or sculpture will not be accepted.
 - 3. Schedule for the day of the Event, Sunday October 1
 - Check-In is 8 11 AM: The check-in tent will be at the UCB garden at Midland and Wellington. Park on either side of the garden. The registration fee is \$20 before October 1, and \$25 the day of the event. The student fee is \$10. Checks or cash only at registration, October 1.
 - 1:30-3 PM Turn in Artwork: Completed artwork from the day or from the month of September MUST be turned in by 3 PM to the reception site (TBD) to qualify for display and judging. Artists are expected to supply an easel for each piece submitted. Only three pieces can be submitted.
 - **4 PM Judging.** Judging is closed to the public.

5 - 7 PM – Reception Centennial Commons, 7210 Olive Blvd.

Artwork will be displayed and available for purchase during the reception. Artists and a "plus one" will be guests of U City in Bloom and encouraged to attend. Winners will be announced, and prizes will be awarded during the event.

- 4. **Sales:** Each piece of artwork must have a title and price and will be considered for sale during the reception event unless otherwise specified. U City in Bloom will take a 20% commission on all sales.
- 5. **Eligibility:** The competition is open to artists 18 and over plus High School students in 10th 12th grade. There is a separate category for High School work and will be judged separately.
- 6. **Prizes:** Cash prizes will be \$250 for Best in Show, \$200 for Second Place, and \$150 for Third Place. A non-cash prize will be awarded to the winner of the People's Choice voting during the event.
 - Youth prizes will be \$70 1st place; \$50 2nd place; \$40 3rd place, all Youth art will be included in the online Gallery show.
- 7. **Gallery Show and Sales Online:** To be included in the show, artist must take a photo of each piece submitted, up to three. Art will be posted on UCB webpage and will remain until January 2024. Photos must be submitted by email to: eric76@hotmail.com by October 10.
